Artisans and Quality Crafters Registration

For sculpture, painting, & quality handmade crafts in all media

The Friends of Woodland Community Library Art in Horseshoe Park feature only original, creative, hand-made quality arts and crafts. Makers will be approved, relative to the integrity, originality, level of craftsmanship and artistic merit of their work, and be safe and durable for its intended use. The vendor's work must be predominant and the starting material must be significantly altered and/or enhanced by the vendor.

We do not accept anyone selling any kind of commercial mass-produced or resale goods. All goods MUST be HAND-MADE by the REGISTERED vendor, no resale items will be allowed. Resale of wholesale items (buy/sell) IS NOT permitted and will result in immediate dismissal without refund. Vendors displaying unacceptable merchandise or merchandise not listed on approved applications will be asked to remove items at the discretion of the Coordinator.

- "Artist" means the creator of a work of fine art.

(A) "Work of fine art" means an original art work which is:

(a) A visual rendition including a painting, drawing, sculpture, mosaic, or photograph;

(b) A work of calligraphy;

(c) A work of graphic art including an etching, lithograph, offset print, or silk screen. Reproductions (prints) by the artist of his/her own work may be displayed;

(d) A craft work in materials including clay, textile, fiber, fabric, wood, metal, plastic, or glass; or

(e) A work in mixed media including a collage or a work consisting of any combination of works included in this subsection.

- "Crafter" means the creator of making things by hand: a profession or activity involving the skillful making of decorative or practical objects by hand, or an object produced by skillful handwork, especially in a traditional manner, e.g. weaving, pottery, or woodcarving, sewing.

All artwork/craftwork (where feasible) must be labeled with title and price and artist's name and address. The unauthorized use of copyright designs is illegal and will not be allowed at Art in Horseshoe Park.

Special Criteria For Jewelers:

Jewelry must be innovative, unique, and have strong hand-made elements. It is highly recommended that if you intend to show small fragile artwork, such as delicate jewelry or miniatures, you provide a sturdy, secure display case for your pieces.

Space

1. Display space: Display units 10x10 foot grassy areas at \$40 per space.
2. Booth display should not exceed boundaries. Any exhibitor needing additional space will be expected to reserve two (or more as needed) spaces. Canopies and tents, including any connecting wires or stakes, **MUST** be totally contained within the exhibitors assigned space. **Vendors must safely weight or stake any canopy or cover they use at the art show for shelter against inclement weather (heat, wind, rain, etc.)**
3. There is no electricity available in park space.
4. Signs are not allowed in walkways.
5. There will be no refunds due to inclement weather. Outdoor exhibitors should be prepared if weather becomes inclement.
6. Three-dimensional work must come with appropriate supports or cases for safe display.

Artist Setup: 6:30 a.m. until 8:30 a.m. All art and displays, must be setup by 8:30 a.m.

Open to public: 9:00 a.m. until 6 p.m.

Tear down starting at 6 p.m., all items must be removed by 9:00 p.m., September 6th.

Application Guidelines

1. A completed application must be postmarked or emailed by July 24. Applications not returned to Friends of Woodland Community Library by the specified deadline will not be given space request consideration.
2. A \$40 check, made out to the Friends of Woodland Community Library. Postdated checks will not be accepted. Credit cards ARE NOT accepted.
3. Space must be reserved and all fees paid in advance. Your space is not definite until we have received your completed reservation form, release form and payment.
4. Photos (4 x 6 color) or digital photos on CD that are representative of the work you intend to display at the festival and a check must accompany completed application. Include one detail, plain backgrounds are preferred. Please no slides. Photos and CD's become property of Friends of the Library and will not be returned.
5. A written description of the process and the materials used is also required. The more information you can give on paper and film, the easier it is for them to approve.
6. Confirmations will be mailed no later than one month prior to show date.

Smoking is allowed only in designated smoking areas.

Vendor's pets are strongly discouraged except for service dogs.

Terms of Participation

The Art in Horseshoe Park terms of participation are NON-NEGOTIABLE. The Friends of Woodland Community Library reserve the right to deny registration to any applicant or entry on day of event.

As a participant in Art in Horseshoe Park, I agree to the following:

1. I, the artist/applicant, will be responsible for my own cash transactions including any sales tax that may apply.
2. I, the artist/applicant waive any responsibility to the Friends of Woodland Community Library and its volunteers, Fort Vancouver Regional Library Foundation, and the City of Woodland for any injury, loss or theft of, or damage to anything I bring into the park on September 6, 2008. The artist/applicant hereby agrees to defend, indemnify and hold harmless Friends of Woodland Community Library, Fort Vancouver Regional Library District, and the City of Woodland, their officers, agents, successors and assigns from and against any and all claims, demands, actions or causes of actions, suits at law or inequity of any nature or character arising out of or by reason of any act or omission of the second party or its agents in the performance of rights, duties, and obligations of the second party under this agreement. The second party understands that Friends of Woodland Community Library assumes no responsibility or liability for any property of the second party, which may be located on the above-described premises. For and in consideration of permission to participate in The Friends of Woodland Community Library Art in Horseshoe Park, the specified above shall be subject to acts of God or any condition or circumstances beyond the control of the Friends of the Library which shall prevent the carrying out of some or all of the show. Friends of the Library, upon the occurrence of such an event, shall have the right to terminate this agreement without liability of any nature.
3. I, the artist/applicant, agree that booths will be erected with concern for public safety. VENDORS MUST SAFELY WEIGHT OR STAKE ANY CANOPY OR COVER THEY USE AT THE ART SHOW for shelter against inclement weather (heat, wind, rain, etc.) All vendors who wish to erect canopies/umbrellas on the Art in Horseshoe Park site during the show, including the set up and break down period, are required to have their canopies sufficiently and safely weighted and/or anchored to the ground from the time their canopy is put up to the time it is taken down. Any vendor who fails to properly anchor his or her canopy will not be allowed to sell at show, unless that vendor chooses to take and stow their canopy and sell without it. Any side wall or cover materials must be certified fire retardant per fire department guidelines.
4. I, the artist/applicant, agree to pay the \$40 registration fee. I understand the registration fee is non-refundable in the event of cancellation by the Artist after August 15th, 2008.
5. I, the artist/applicant, understand that a space will be assigned to me according to the category and discretion of the Friends of Woodland Community Library.
6. I, the artist/applicant, agree that all articles for sale will be handmade by the vendor.
7. I, the artist/applicant, agree to be present on the day of the event.
8. I, the artist/applicant, understand that if I set up in the morning I am committed to staying until 6 p.m., and all items will be removed from the show area by 9:00 p.m. on September 6th.
9. I, the artist/applicant, understand that Friends of Woodland Community Library make the final decision regarding my participation.
